that occurs over extended breaks from school.*

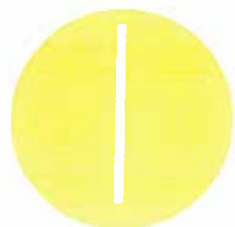
*Attached is a BINGO board that we have created to inspire

Help prepare a meal

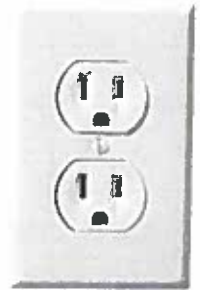
