

Travel Policy (for Students and Staff)

(Updated 3/1/22)

*Applies to all FSMA students and staff (vaccinated or not-vaccinated)

Families/Staff will be expected to communicate to the nurse if they have traveled to a “High Transmission Rate” area so that we can support strict mask wearing for the student.

When staff/students travel out of the county, they should check the transmission rate (using this link <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/your-health/covid-by-county.html>), and follow the guidance below:

People may choose to mask at any time. People with symptoms, a positive test, or exposure to someone with COVID-19 should wear a mask.
